HISTORY

This method of instruction was pioneered by newspaper editor Thomas Foster, founder of the International Correspondence Schools, to help coal miners educate themselves. Since its founding in 1890 in Shenandoah, Pennsylvania, the school has developed into a worldwide educational system headquartered in Scranton, Pennsylvania.

ACCREDITATION

Effective November 2, 2002, the high school has been regionally accredited for grades 9 through adult by the Commission on Secondary Schools of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, 3624 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104.

Penn Foster High School is accredited by Cognia. Cognia is the parent organization of the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI), Northwest Accreditation Commission (NWAC) and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI). Penn Foster High School is also accredited by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC) located in Washington, D.C.

Accreditation by these agencies means that Penn Foster High School has demonstrated its ability to perform the education functions we claim and meet stated educational objectives. In addition, Penn Foster High School is licensed by the Pennsylvania State Board of Private Licensed Schools, based in Harrisburg, PA.
